## Outpatient Behavioral Health Services

Outpatient Behavioral Health Services includes an Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) for individuals who are in need of more frequent or intensive intervention. Mrinal Mullick, M.D. is the Medical Director for the IOP program.

In addition to the IOP, Outpatient Services includes individualized psychotherapy for the following conditions:

- Mood, anxiety, and stress problems
- Adjustment problems
- Relationship problems
- Recovery from trauma
- Coping with chronic mental illness
- Psychological management of chronic pain
- Psychological testing for memory and cognitive functioning
- Psychological evaluation for suitability for bariatric surgery



**John Linden, Psy.D.** is a licensed clinical psychologist. He earned his doctoral degree from Spalding University in Louisville, Kentucky in 1992 following an APA-approved internship at the Vanderbilt/VA Clinical Psychology Consortium. He has worked with a wide range of patient populations including veterans.
